



The Future of Worlingham

A Neighbourhood Plan is an important way for a community to have an impact upon the way things change. Our draft Neighbourhood Plan 2020 - 2036 is now at the first formal consultation stage (running from Thursday 1 April to Wednesday 9 June 2021).

After this stage where we take your comments on board, we will be able to submit it to the East Suffolk Council for further public consultation and then for examination. And after that there will be a referendum for the village to finally approve or reject the plan.

Using your feedback to the Neighbourhood Plan Questionnaire (2016), the draft plan has policies that would:

- protect the village's identity and influence the mix and the character of new housing;
- ensure we are fully consulted about new amenities;
- make sure there will be new walking and cycling routes, and enough parking spaces for the new homes;
- promote attractive landscaping and effective drainage;
- and protect our parks from being built upon.
