SCC Cllr Brambley-Crawshaw - had provided a written report - circulated to all members.

ESC written report had been circulated prior to meeting.

Path along the playing field at Park Drive is getting overgrown – Norse to be asked to cut back.

4. Chairman's Report including;

- *Xmas card* it was agreed that the card looked very good and will hopefully be well received.
- o Fencing for play area by school CIIr Summerfield advised that the school were looking into the fencing around the play area. Concern was voiced about ensuring that there are 2 entrances /exits, the entrance for cutting machinery to be appropriate and the height of the fence to be as Rospa requires. These matters to be discussed with Concertus.
- o Parking around school Cllr Robbins advised that a very good meeting had been held with school governors and all seemed as concerned as councillors about school parking. See report from Peter Hobbs. It had been agreed that signage and educating parents and children was

vital to ensure safety – and the need to encourage other methods of transport ie cycling and walking. ESC ward councillor budget to be requested to assist with signage, line painting etc. No extra parking spaces are likely to be provided on site.

- School contact it was agreed that the council would write to the new head of school in January to introduce the council.
- o Maintenance of Garden Lane banked area The chair had met with Richard Hackney from Norse to discuss the banked area. There are now only about 3 areas of brambles on the site. Tree stump Norse are happy to lower this. Discussion about Clinks Care Farm doing the maintenance Norse will consider and get back to us.
- Pocket Parks council to consider other areas.
- o Garden Lane traffic count figures- the speed readings had been low due to the road works in the area potentially slowing traffic down. However, the traffic count is suitable for a 20mph zone outside the school. Cllr Brambley- Crawshaw to progress.
- o *Bio-Cow visit* Cllr Summerfield reported on the visit there was no smell on the day of the visit. Residents to be advised to report any smells to the Environmental Health Officer at ESC.
